GUEST PREACHER: DAYLE K. BARRETT



Pastor Dayle hails from London, England, where he was the twice-elected Member of Youth Parliament for Bexley Borough, and recipient of the Worshipful Company of the Glaziers' Award for Community Service. His ministry arc began at the age of 12, when he began serving as a Sunday School Teacher, Worship Leader, and then Youth Pastor in the New Testament

Church of God. In later years, he was involved in church planting and outreach ministry, having been ordained in the Tabernacle of Refuge in 2016.

Since 2019, Dayle has offered spiritual leadership in the United Church of Canada, serving churches in Simcoe, York, and Wellandport. In June 2024, he became a pastor at Timothy Eaton Memorial Church, where he is undergoing a Supervised Ministry Experience as a candidate for ordination in the United Church of Canada.

Dayle holds a BTEC First Diploma in Public Services from the Cadet Vocational Qualifications Organization and a Master of Divinity from Emmanuel College. At convocation, he was awarded the 2024 Sanford Gold Medal in Divinity – their highest honor for “scholarship, ability, and character.”

Dayle is passionate about proclaiming the gospel, making disciples, and building faithful community. As a scholar, however, his main interests are in biblical theology, which he hopes to pursue at the doctorate level.

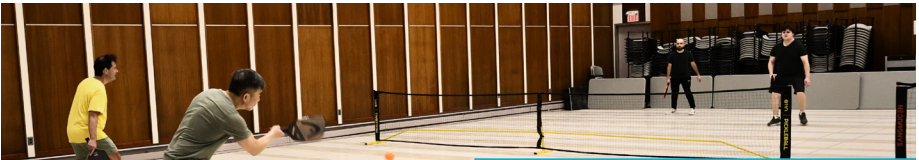
