Is piano percussion? Duo Kaji dissects the playful and sometimes puzzling relationship between piano and percussion—a pairing rarely heard in concert halls. How have these instruments shaped one another, and in what ways do they differ? The program moves from Clementi to living composers, and from folk tunes to electronics, highlighting the boundless sonic possibilities that emerge when the two instrumental worlds meet. Through Toronto-based ensemble Duo Kaji, Japanese pianist Mai Miyagaki and Costa Rican percussionist Randall Chaves Camacho explore and blend what they find familiar and unfamiliar in the music they encounter today.

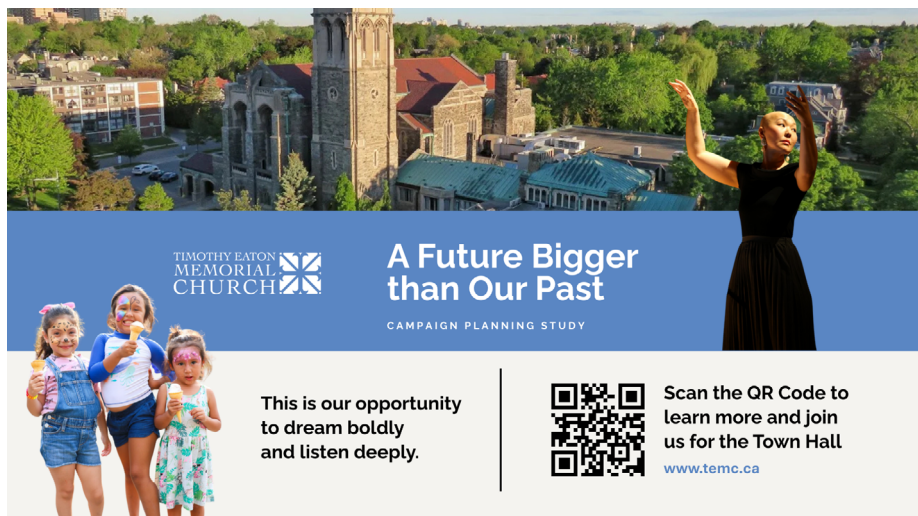
