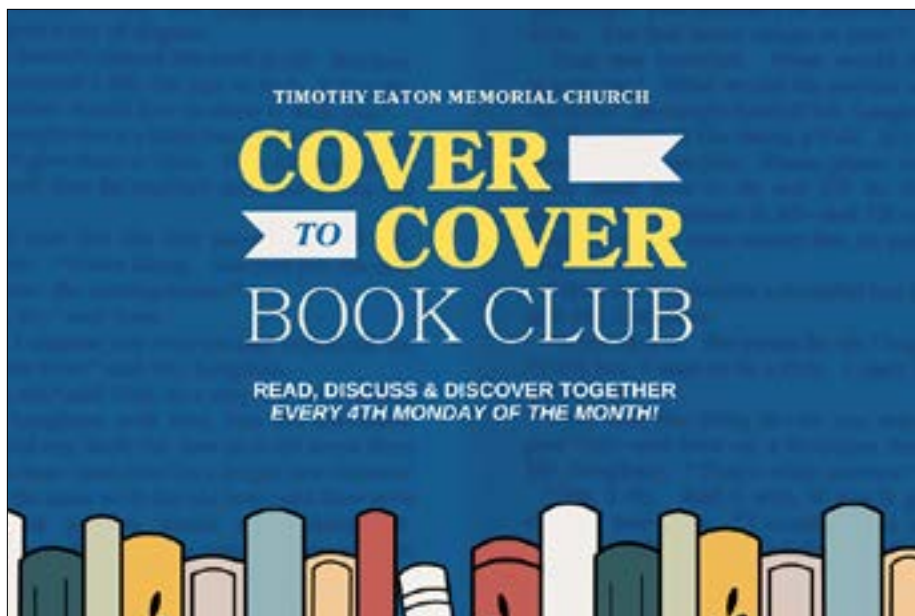


IN MEMORIAM
