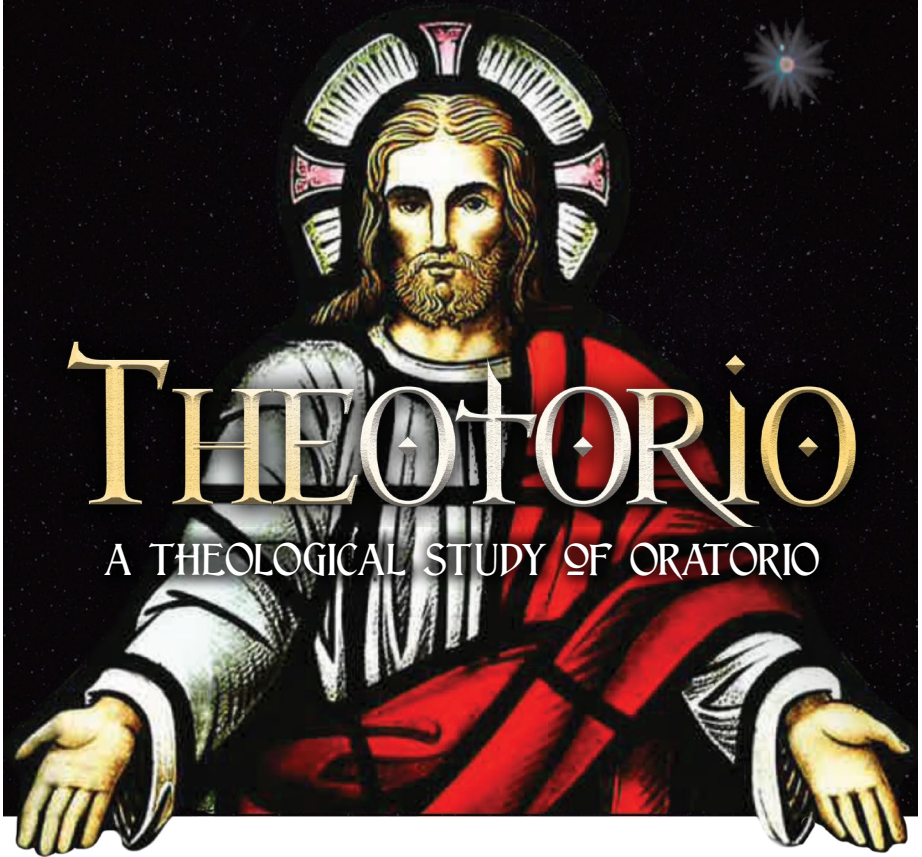
## **CHRISTMAS PAGEANT 2019**

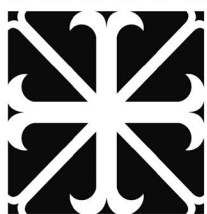
